National Night Out is designed to:

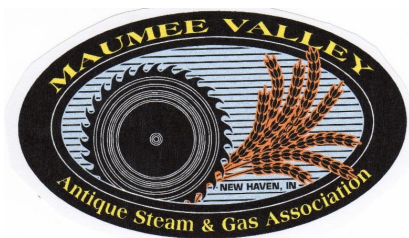
- Heighten crime and drug prevention awareness
