in 1957 by Marvin Stieglitz, who began by selling bagged feed from their farm in Harlan, Indiana. Eventually, Marvin and Joan purchased a mill in Harlan and quickly outgrew the facility. When the sight owned by the Brueggeman family on Doty Road went up for sale in 1963, it seemed the perfect location for the growing business.



Lynn Stieglitz who is the oldest son and current general manager of Milan Center Feed and Grain said, "This particular facility was built in 1948 right after the war. It is kind of amazing when I look at it; it was built out of rough sawn logs and big timbers. I think it was probably state of the art building in its day."

What made this location even better was a large home to raise a growing family. Stieglitz shared that the family moved next door in 1971 He said, "I was intrigued with the variety of things going on next door so I would come over and help out after school."

Bulldog Bash

Celebrating the Old High School Near Schnelker Park



The iconic red brick building that was once New Haven High School which, more recently, has served as the middle school, is about to become extinct. But before it goes, there will be a farewell celebration.

Saturday, June 1, just two days before the middle school razing begins, a New Haven High School "classes reunion" of sorts will be held at Schnelker Park to say goodbye to the school that had been NHHS for thousands of graduates until its closure in 1977.

Festivities begin at 3 p.m. when New Haven High School alumni, friends, former teachers, administrators and even the curious are invited for a final walk-through of the building, which concludes at 7 p.m.

At 5 p.m., the goodbye party continues at Schnelker Park near the former New Haven High, where what has been dubbed the "Bulldog Bash" will be held until 9 p.m. The \$20 per person cost, whether purchased presale or at the door, will include food catered by Rack & Helen's, live music, and a souvenir brick from the school. A cash bar of beer, wine and soda will be available. Additionally, nametags will be provided to help sort out members of each graduating class. Because tables and chairs will be limited, those attending are urged to bring their own lawn chairs.

The menu includes a pulled pork sandwich, side dishes of loaded potato salad and baked beans, and one beverage of choice.

Indiana Public Service Co. (NIPSCO) plans to reinvest nearly \$660 million in improvements to its electric and gas infrastructure across Northern Indiana in 2019. These updates will continue to provide safe and reliable energy for customers.

Work scheduled for 2019:

- 1,776 wooden utility poles and 86 miles of overhead electrical transmission lines
- 162,000 feet of underground electrical cable lines, 18 power transformers and 98 circuit breakers
- 7,393 existing streetlights to energy-efficient, long-lasting LED lights
- 10 miles of natural gas pipeline and upgrades to natural gas regulator stations
- Continued program to expand natural gas in-line inspection technology and system capabilities
