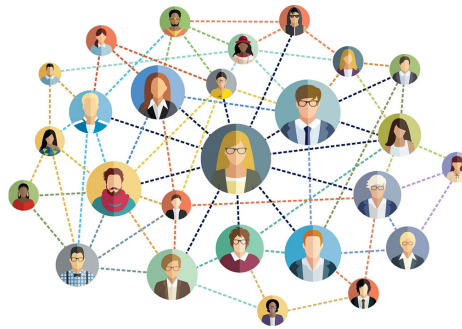

2021 Citizens’ Academy

New Haven is once again offering this interactive forum for citizens to learn first-hand how the City of New Haven is structured and managed. Residents will also learn the City's relationship with Allen County and other public agencies; what services and programs are available through various city agencies; how to access needed services; and how to apply this knowledge by serving as an information resource for neighborhoods, non-profit groups and local businesses in New Haven.
